The Greene County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, November 17, 2025, at 6:00 PM in the Greene County Operations Center. Present for the meeting: Chairman Bennie Heath, Vice-Chairman Jerry Jones, Commissioner Derek Burrell, Commissioner Ray Johnson, Commissioner Robert Taylor, Jr., County Manager Kyle DeHaven, County Attorney Kevin MacQueen, and Deputy Clerk Kathy Mooring.

A. Call to Order

Chairman Bennie Heath called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM, and gave the Invocation and led the Pledge to the Flag.

G. County Manager

1. American Red Cross Rose & Ronald Bowen Tennis Classic

Mr. DeHaven presented a request to sponsor the 20th Annual American Red Cross Rose & Ronald Bown Tennis Classic. Mr. DeHaven asked the Board's wishes, and level of sponsorship.

On a motion by Vice-Chairman Jones and seconded by Commissioner Johnson, the Board voted unanimously to approve at the Supporter Level \$150.

2. Diversified Opportunities, Inc.

Mr. DeHaven presented a request to make a donation to a service that is available to Greene County residents with disabilities. Diversified Opportunities, Inc. is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization in Wilson County that serves Wilson, Wayne, and Greene Counties. Commissioner Burress recused himself from voting on this as, although he has no personal or financial interest in the organization, he serves as Vice-Chairman of the North Carolina State Rehabilitation Council.

On a motion by Vice-Chairman Jones and seconded by Commissioner Johnson, the Board voted unanimously to approve donating at the Silver Level, \$1,000.

3. Parking Improvements partnership with Town of Snow Hill

Mr. DeHaven next presented a request from the Town of Snow Hill to partner with them to implement an improved parking plan for the area around the new splash pad on Hines and School Streets. The Town will install a drainage system to help manage water flow during heavy rain events to minimize property damage on their property and the adjoining County properties. They asked that we pave from the property lines to the drain culvert in front of the Senior Center.

On a motion by Commissioner Taylor, Jr. and seconded by Vice-Chairman Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve.

Chairman Heath announced that we will be getting federal funding for a new Senior Center.
