Call to Order

- Chairman Bobby Taylor called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and Mr. Donald Beaman gave the Invocation.
- Chairman Bobby Taylor asked Kathy Mooring to do the roll call. Roll call was done and we had 6 of 9 voting members present, quorum was met.
- Chairman Bobby Taylor asked for a motion to approve the May 15, 2024 minutes. On motion by Brandon Sutton and seconded by Trey Cash, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

Division II, Transportation Report

Len White gave the report for Aaron Bullard. Resurfacing (DB00574) has been awarded to Barnhill Contracting (\$3.0M). Anticipate work to be done in 2025. Greene County maps include 4 roads totaling 4.8 miles. Other roads may substitute the two roads being delayed due to school construction.

SR 1328 (Newell Rd)

SR 1444 (Carolina Dr)

SR 1358 (School Dr) these two maps to be replaced due to planned High School

SR 1359 (Rebel Rd) construction; replacement map to be determined.

Review State Transportation Implementation Plan (STIP)

Mikey stated that score is ongoing and moving into prioritizing, reminded all of the ECRPO meeting tomorrow and then things will move into division input phase.

Old Business/New Business/Roundtable

Bobby Taylor asked Kingold/Hull Road project possibly being delayed. Jeremy Stroud said it may be delayed, there hasn't been a final decision as of yet. He also went over possibilities for this project.

Jeremy Stroud stated the 4th and Greene Street stop light will be moving into a temporary 4-way stop to how it will work. The light will remain and flash red in all directions. The town has not approved moving into a full 4-way stop, this will only be temporary.

April Vinson asked Jeremy Stroud about the Blanket Encroachment that contractors are being told they have to have when doing typical work (taps, etc). Jeremy Stroud explained what the blanket encroachment is for and if work being done is for a new commercial project a separate encroachment/permit must be applied for. Contractors also must have proper safety procedures in place when doing this kind of work, safety cones, signs of utility work ahead and people directing traffic.

Kyle DeHaven stated the county is looking into setting up a fine for not having trash covered upon arrival at the landfill. He stated other counties do the same and it will help with the littering issue in the County.

On motion by Brandon Sutton and seconded by Kelly Radford to adjourn, the Committee voted to adjourn.

Bobby Taylor adjourned the meeting at 9:10 a.m.
